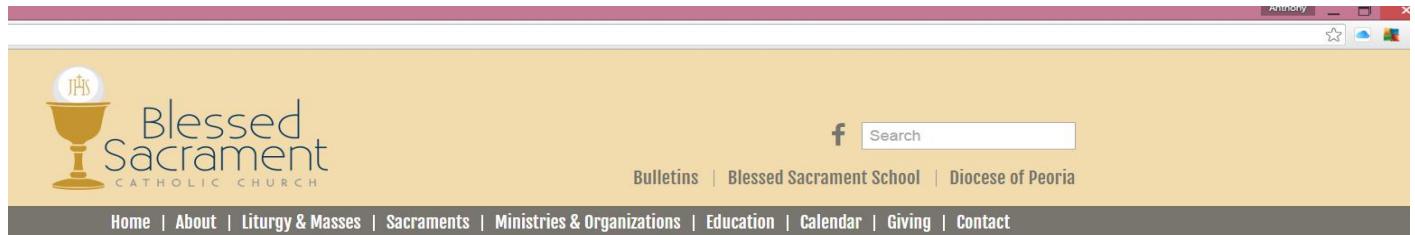


Online Giving 101

Step 1: Click on Giving then Online Giving

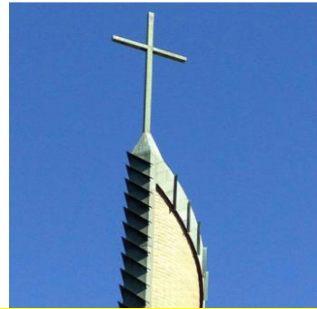

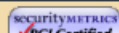

Instructions for those currently using online giving:

After logging into your online giving account, you may add pledge payments for the ***Bringing to Completion the Good Work Begun Capital Campaign*** in one of two ways.

1. If you'd like to add your pledge payments to an existing transaction, simply click the Edit link on the right side of your current transaction. You can then add your pledge payment amount in the New Facilities Fund column.
2. If you'd like to create a new transaction for your pledge payments, click the *Add Transaction* link that is above the list of your existing transactions. You can then set up a new transaction for your payments to the New Facilities Fund.
